Dear Electra ISD Parents, Students, and Staff:

I am writing to you to inform you that Electra ISD will be switching to “remote only” learning starting on Friday, November 6th and going through Friday November 13th. There will be no face to face instruction during this time.

Although we feel that face to face instruction is still the best platform for student learning and performance, the COVID 19 positive cases in our community and school continue to rise and the number of quarantined individuals continue to rise as well. As of 1:00 pm on Thursday Nov 5th, more than 75 students and staff members are either positive or in close contact quarantine. We ask that you keep these classmates, coworkers, and family members in your thoughts and prayers.

The Texas Education Agency allows Texas school districts to close for COVID-19 related reasons for up to 5 consecutive days to clean and disinfect facilities. Electra ISD Maintenance Personnel will be deep cleaning and disinfecting all classrooms, common area, offices, and cafeterias during the closure.

We ask that our parents and students keep in mind that the purpose of this closure is to try and break the cycle of the spread of this virus. If students continue to congregate outside of school without using masks and practicing safe social distancing, we will not be able to stop the spread of the coronavirus.

We apologize for the inconvenience that this closure may cause. Breakfast and lunch will still be available for pick up at Electra Elementary each day of the closure for all Electra ISD students. Go to www.electraisd.net for instructions on how to complete an order form for meals.
