The Grand Jurors for the County of Wilbarger, State of Texas, duly selected, impaneled, sworn, charged and organized as such at the July Term, A.D. 2021, of the 46th District Court of said County, upon their oaths present in and to said Court, that BRIAN POUNDS, on or about the 1st day of July A.D. 2021 and before the presentment of this indictment, in said County and State, did then and there intentionally and knowingly cause the [REDACTED] of the [REDACTED] of Jane Doe, a pseudonym, hereafter styled the complainant, a child who was then and there younger than 17 years of age, by defendant's [REDACTED], without the consent of the complainant, and the defendant did then and there by acts or words threaten to cause or place, the complainant in fear that death or serious bodily injury would be imminently inflicted on Jane Doe, and the acts or words occurred in the presence of the complainant;

COUNT V

It is further presented that said Defendant, on or about the 1st day of July, 2021, and before the presentment of this indictment, in the County and State aforesaid, did then and there, with intent to arouse or gratify the sexual desire of the defendant, cause Jane Doe, hereafter styled the complainant, a child younger than 17 years of age, to engage in sexual contact by causing the complainant to [REDACTED] defendant;

COUNT VI

It is further presented that said Defendant, on or about the 1st day of July, 2021, and before the presentment of this indictment, in the County and State aforesaid, did then and there, knowingly deliver, by actual transfer, a controlled substance, namely, methamphetamine, to Jane Doe, a pseudonym, a person younger than 18 years of age;
