This morning at approximately 7:35 a TikTok video surfaced containing an implied threat to Henrietta ISD schools. Campus administrators, district security, and three different law enforcement agencies are aware of the concern and are actively taking measures to identify the TikTok account used to post the video statement. All students at the Henrietta ISD campuses are safe.

There will be an increase in security sweeps by campus administration and district security in response to the threat. During this time, Texas State Troopers will have an active presence at all HISD campuses.

Thankfully, the “see something, say something” by HISD students triggered increased safety precautions to protect the HISD community.

Social media is a powerful tool often used to influence and not always for good. It is always important to remain vigilant when it involves these types of threats. HISD takes every threat seriously.

Henrietta ISD wants to make sure that students, parents, and community members understand they play an essential role in informing district administration of any threat made to schools, students, staff.
